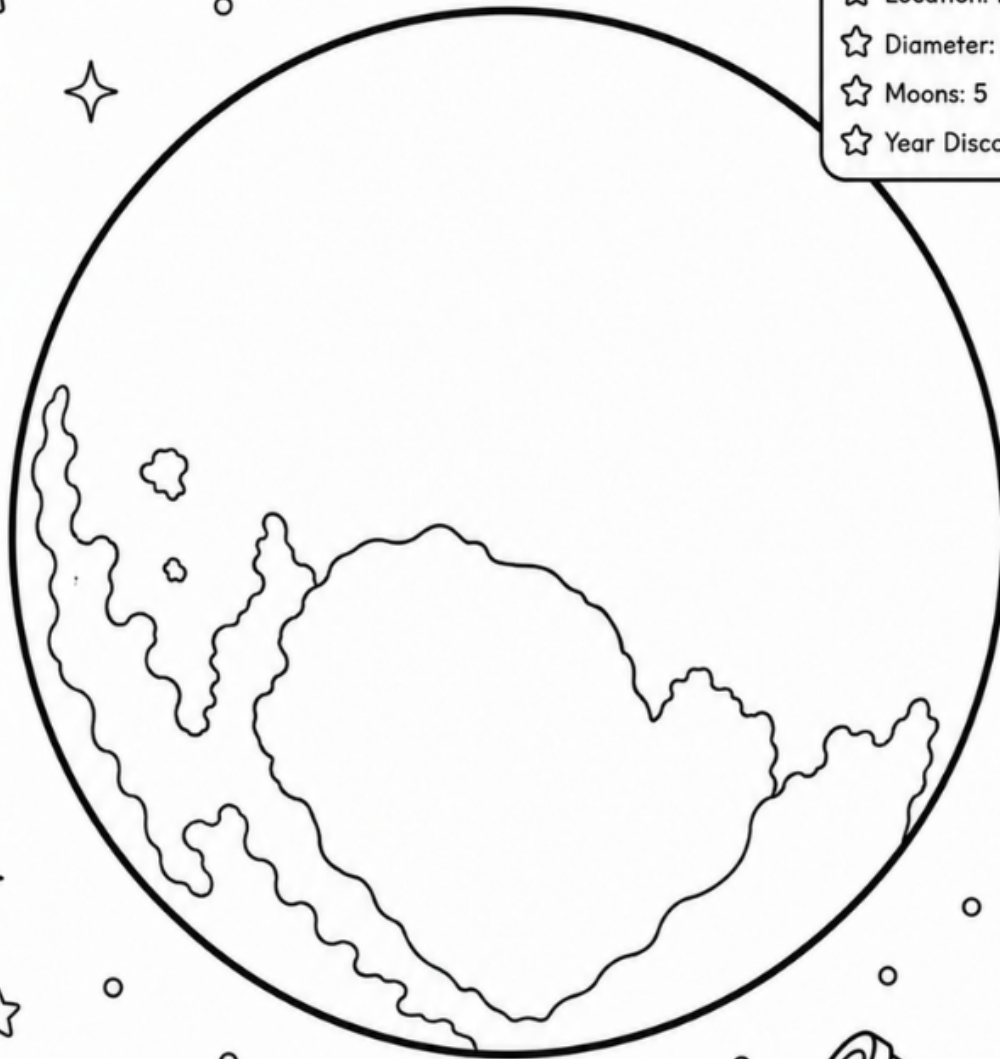


PLUTO
